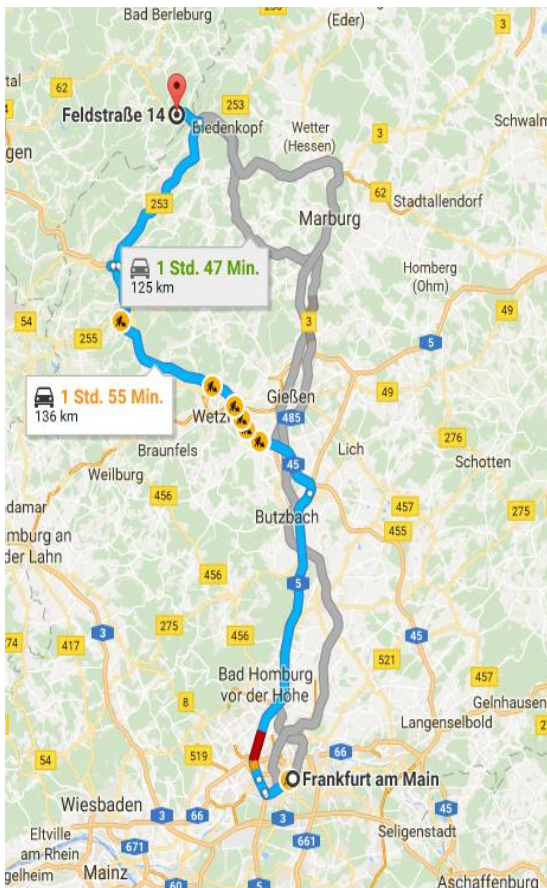
General Information

Background

Nowadays, the demands on joining technology are becoming constantly higher. More performance with less weight and a small installation space are the most common demands. A further requirement is the efficiency in assembly regarding **process reliability** and **quality**.

A screw connection, which might first be considered as a “minor matter”, can become an absolute disaster in case the screw connection fails. The **image** and **profitably** of a product highly depends on the right screw design.

With the previous considerations in mind, we are offering a seminar, which provides a proper **basis** for carrying out screw design more deliberately and more specifically. The basic principles of bolting technology will be discussed from the screw/nut to the modern screwdriver. The process capability and monitoring as well as the necessary quality monitoring tools will be presented. The participants will be familiar with the most frequently **cited guidelines and standards** and will be more confident and conscious regarding the design of future screw applications.
